The position is:

- Full- time
- Monday to Friday
- 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- 10 weekly sessions in July and August
- Dates: Monday, July 5 to Friday, August 27, 2021
- Training/orientation: Date TBD

Age Groups:

4 and 5 year olds (JK/SK) 6 to 9 year olds (Gr. 1 to 3)

Locations: Oakville Elementary Campus, Oakville Primary Campus, Meadowvale Elementary Campus

Credentials/Qualifications:

Police Check/VSS required
CPR/First Aid required

Experience:

Previous experience working with children is ideal

Pay:

Hourly pay ranges from \$18 to \$21 based on experience and role responsibility (assisting with vs. leading own camp group)

Duties:

- Plan, organize, and lead age appropriate "fun" activities based on a weekly theme (arts and crafts, "outdoor structured activities, cooperative games...)
- -Conduct daily group circle activities (read -alouds, story telling, songs, mindfulness activities, finger play etc..)
- Purchase necessary supplies for activities, including art and crafts (to be reimbursed)
- -Supervise students at all times, ensuring the safety and security of students
- Set up classroom each morning (lights on, music on, chairs down, organize activities/centres etc..)
- -Be knowledgeable of, and practise emergency procedures (lock –down/hold & secure, Epi-pen use, First Aid, fire evacuation...)
- -Take candid photos for end of week newsletter/social media updates to families
- -Maintain a tidy and attractive classroom environment with light cleaning duties for lunch, snack, and end of day
- -Communicate issues to admin and families in a timely manner
- -Work collegially and collaboratively with summer camp and office staff
- -Perform either lunch or recess supervision duty daily
- Assist with arrival/dismissal of students at end of day
- -Bring injured and/or sick children to front office for care/basic First Aid
- -Maintain accurate records (attendance, injuries, etc.)
- -Comply with Rotherglen Code of Conduct and Behaviour Management Policies
- -Other duties as assigned
